NAAC Accreditation A Milestone for WIRAS

Wadihuda Institute of Research and Advanced Studies (WIRAS) has been awarded the NAAC B++ grade following a rigorous two-day evaluation by the NAAC Peer Team on October 23 and 24, 2024—marking a precious moment in the institution's short but impactful history. The expert panel comprised Dr. Roda Sayanna, former Vice-Chancellor of Kakatiya University; Dr. Kishori Nayak, former Dean at Mangalore University; and Dr. Sumathi Mohan, Professor at Bharathiar University. WIRAS Students Shine in Research:

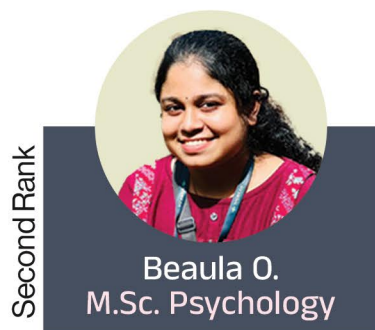
A Landmark Year in Academic Excellence (2024–25)

WIRAS Creates History at Kannur University Arts Fest 2025



Marking a milestone in its 15-year journey, WIRAS delivered its best-ever performance at the Kannur University Arts Fest 2025, securing an impressive 75 points and finishing 10th overall among all participating colleges.
